The Town of Deer Lake will be holding a spring cleanup drop-off at the public works depot on Gatehouse Road. There will be no curbside spring clean-up for 2021. Any resident of Deer Lake will be able to drop off acceptable items on April 29th, April 30th, May 1st, May 6th, May 7th, and May 8th. Please observe the list of acceptable and unacceptable items for the drop-off site. Residents will be required to present a photo ID with a Deer Lake address to prove resi-

dency at the I.D. Check. Please refer to the diagram below that illustrates traffic flow through the public works depot site. 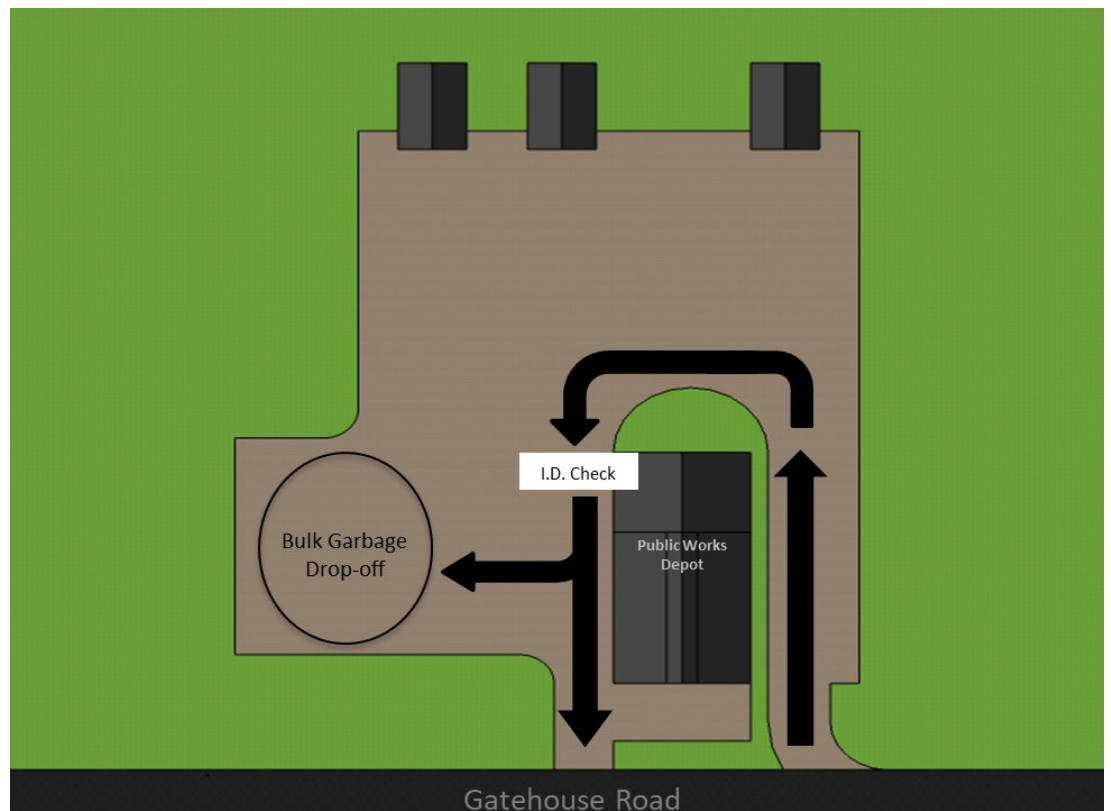

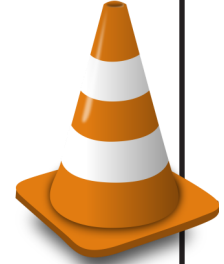


CURBSIDE WASTE COLLECTION

A reminder to residents that the Town of Deer Lake operates on the dual-stream curbside collection scheme implemented by Western Regional Waste Management. Recyclables will be collected in transparent blue bags, while garbage will be put out in clear bags. For your own privacy, two small non-transparent bags may be placed inside each clear bag.

REPORT A POTHOLE

The effects of the rise and fall of temperatures will have negative effects on some of our municipal roads. With this in mind the Town of Deer Lake is encouraging its residents to assist with tackling this annual issue by reporting any potholes that can be identified on our roads.

We ask that residents provide a physical location of the pothole (civic address) and a general description (size, depth, near shoulder, center of road).
