

Public Notice Mandatory Water Conservation Effective June 22, 2021

A Town of Deer Lake water conservation plan ensures residents will have ample water pressure for consumption, cleaning, cooking and most importantly ensuring sufficient water pressure is present for Deer Lake Fire Rescue to fight fires in the area.

The Town is attempting to alleviate this problem where extreme conditions exist. However, residents of Deer Lake and Reidville are asked to conserve water during the summer months by adhering to the following water conservation measures;

1. Please restrict watering lawns and gardens to the hours of <u>6:00 am to 8:00 am and</u> <u>8:00 pm to 10:00 pm</u>, two days per week, in accordance with the following schedule:

(a) Even civic numbers (end in 2, 4, 6, 8, or 0) on Wednesday and Saturday(b) Odd civic numbers (end in 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9) on Thursday and Sunday

- 2. New lawns and landscaping may be watered on any day however, watering should be limited to the hours of <u>6:00 am to 8:00 am and 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm</u>.
- 3. Please use a watering can or hose with an automatic shutoff nozzle when watering trees, shrubs, flowers and vegetable gardens.
- 4. Please use a hose with an automatic shutoff nozzle when washing vehicles.
- 5. Car washes for fund-raising, as well as siding and window washing is permitted with the use of an automatic shutoff nozzle. Free flowing car washes, even for the purposes of fund-raising, are not permitted.

Municipal Enforcement will be monitoring these measures to ensure compliance. Those failing to comply with these measures could be subject to a monetary fine and may have water to the property turned off.
