

## **AMENDMENT**

## **Poll Tax Policy**

Be it resolved that the Town of Deer Lake adopt a Poll Tax Policy in relation to common-law couples to state that if the said couple is living together for a period of a minimum of one year and that the said couple either

- 1. Obtain an affidavit to state that they are living as married (common-law).
- 2. Have both names listed on the deed to the property.
- 3. If property owners have co-signers and the property is not in their name we require an affidavit from the financial institution stating that the mortgage, taxes and insurances are being paid by the person applying for exemption from poll tax.

It would then be addressed – for taxation purposed – the same as any other married couple in the town of Deer Lake boundary.
