BICYCLE HELMET REGULATIONS

Pursuant to authority conferred by Section 246 of the Municipalities Act, Chapter M-23, the Town of Deer Lake has made the following regulations.

MAYOR

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the TOWN OF DEER LAKE (Bicycle Helmet) Regulations.
- 2. Interpretation: In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:
- a. "Act" means the Municipal Act
- b. "Council" means Town Council of Deer Lake
- c. "Bicycle" means every device having two (2) tandem wheels propelled by human power.
- d. "Bicycle Helmet" means a helmet that is designed for bicycle use and is approved by the Canadian Standards Association, the Snell Memorial Foundation or the American National Standards Institute.
- e. "Street" means any street, road, highway, alley, boulevard, bridge, court, footway, lane, park, public drive, sidewalk, square, or any other way designed or intended for public use for the passage of vehicles and/or pedestrians and any part of any of them open to public use.

- 3. No person shall ride on or operate a bicycle on a street unless that person is wearing a bicycle helmet that complies with these regulations and the chin strap of the helmet is securely fastened under the chin.
- 4. No parent or guardian of a person under the age of twelve shall authorize or knowingly permit that person to ride on or operate a bicycle on a street unless that person is wearing a bicycle helmet as required by these regulations.
- 5. Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these regulations is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties in Section 448 of the Act.
- 6. These regulations were adopted by resolution at a meeting of Council held on the 11th. of July 1994 and will come into effect on the 1st. of September 1994.
