Request for Quotes (RFQ)
Curb side Bulk Garbage Pickup and Disposal
Spring Clean Up

1. Invitation to Proponents

The Town of Deer Lake invites proposals from qualified contractors to provide curb side bulk clean up and disposal at Wild Cove or Hampden.

2. Scope of Work

To systematically go around the Town of Deer Lake and pick up bulk garbage that residents put out curb side. This will not be regular household garbage. A list of permitted items will be given to the contractor, if there are non permitted items on the list at the curb, contractor is to refuse pick up and the town will need to be notified of the address and resident will be contacted by the town. All waste to be delivered to an approved waste disposal site. (Wild Cove or Hampden). Metal waste collected to be sent to an approved metal recycling depot. Wood and electronics can be dropped off at the town depot yard on Gatehouse Road in Deer Lake.

5. Pick up Schedule

Pick up to be between hours of 8 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday. Council will consider times outside this upon written request by contractor. Pickup to begin May 15, 2026 and be completed within three weeks.

6. Equipment

Contractors are responsible for equipment in good working order and up to date MVI for each piece of equipment. No leaking oil, if equipment is found to have leaks they must be taken from site immediately and spill cleaned up.

7. Contractor Requirements

Proponents must provide:

- Current Equipment MVI



Proof of liability insurance

- Proof of Workers' Compensation coverage
- References from similar contracts

8. Health and Safety Requirements

The successful contractor must comply with Occupational Health & Safety legislation and WHMIS requirements.

9. Contract Term

The contract will be for a period of 12 months with the Town's option to renew for additional one-year terms based on performance and budget approval.

10. Payment Terms

Payment will be issued thirty days upon receipt of invoice. Payment will be based on total tonnage of materials dropped off at waste disposal site. Weigh slips for each load must be given to the town. Contractor is responsible for tipping fees at waste disposal site.

11. Submission Requirements

Proposals must include:

- Contractor name and contact information
- Total contract price (HST identified separately)
- Confirmation of availability
- References
- Proof of insurance coverage

12. Submission Deadline

Proposals must be received no later than 2:00 p.m. on Friday, May 8, 2026.
